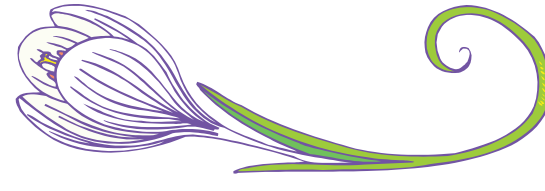

Several parking areas on the hospital campus will be restricted for this drill most of the day on May 6. There will be ample parking across from the Clough Center reserved for families, visitors and staff and it will be visibly marked. Please plan to access the hospital campus through the main entrance on County Road. We expect the drill to run from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

In addition, there will be a large number of National Guard equipment and personnel going through New London in the morning and the afternoon of May 6. Please remember this is just a drill and there is no need for concern. You may want to time your arrival/ departure at the hospital after 8:30 AM and avoid the afternoon departure of the National Guard equipment around 2:30 PM.

All personnel involved in the drill will only have very limited access to the hospital building through specific doors on the lower level in order to use the restrooms.
